Knowledge generation by conducting thematic studies on the local context



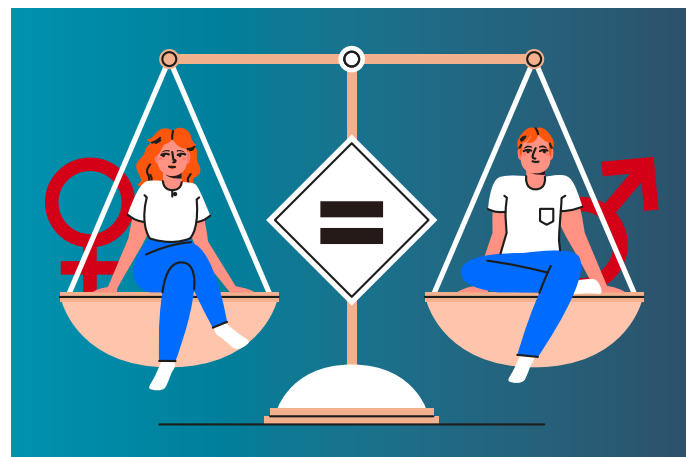
Evidence-based advocacy for enabling legal regimes and policy frameworks. The policies should be county-specific, considering local contexts and needs

1

Provide opportunities for women to participate in public decision-making on policies and government actions.

Make room for civic space advocating for climate justice

4

Enhanced capacity to support the development and strengthening of local level institutions and processes.

5

Enhance coordination between national and county governments in implementing the National Climate Change Action Plan (NCCAP)

6

Adopt social media for passing climate action related information to the members of the public

7

Design concrete “easy sell” actions to attract new climate finance.
